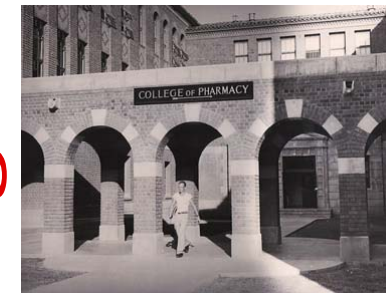


UA College of Pharmacy

The early days... 1947-1948, April 1947, ABOR approves UA School of Pharmacy, under general administration of Col. of Liberal Arts. The School of Pharmacy was first housed in temporary dwelling units (TDU's) that had been transported from the Japanese War Relocation camp at Rivers, Arizona.



1949-1966, Pharmacy Chemistry Bldg. Annex, (Pharmacy becomes a full-fledged college in 1949, making it the first health sciences college at the UA.)



1966-1982, Microbiology Bldg.



1982-current building (will remain as the pharmaceutical sciences bldg.)



New pharmacy building adjacent to the current COP building, to house administrative offices, classroom space, and our pharmaceutical care center, expected occupancy late 2005.

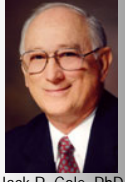

- Explain the characteristics of a new sleep aid, with a unique mechanism of action
- Discuss the clinical applications of two new anti-diabetic agents, each with a unique mechanism of action
