Pharmacy Career Pathways Timeline

- P1 Year
 - September
 - Complete the Pharmacy Career Pathways Form and submit documentation as instructed by the course coordinators to receive credit for the Pharmacy Practice (PhPr 809) assignment.
 - December
 - Review your Pharmacy Practice: Weekly Reflections of a P1 Student journal
 - Which career pathways / specialties were particularly interesting to you? Which ones were not in alignment with your future goals?
 - Complete the Pharmacy Career Pathways Form again
 - Submit the PDF copy of your results to receive credit for the Pharmacy Practice (PhPr 809) assignment per instructions provided by the course coordinators
 - Submit a PDF copy of your results with your portfolio per portfolio instructions

- Review your results and discuss with your mentor during your next meeting
- P2 Year
 - December January
 - Complete the Pharmacy Career Pathways Form
 - Submit a PDF copy of your results with your portfolio
 - Review your results and discuss with your mentor during your next meeting
- P3 Year
 - December January
 - Complete the Pharmacy Career Pathways Form
 - Submit a PDF copy of your results with your portfolio
 - Review your results and discuss with your mentor during your next meeting
- P4 Year
 - December January
 - Complete the Pharmacy Career Pathways Form
 - Submit a PDF copy of your results with your portfolio
 - Review your results and discuss with your mentor during your next meeting

- 5. Save a copy for your personal files.
 - a. Review your results and discuss with your mentor during your next meeting.
 - b. Use the results to help you identify co-curricular opportunities of interest to you.
 - c. Schedule a meeting with faculty and/or community mentors with similar interests to discuss career planning.
 - d. Access some of the career resources (end of the document) in your free time to explore potential careers.
