



GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 18 total units are required. A minimum of 9 of the 18 minor units must be upper-division (300 or 400-level).
- The minor requires at least one course (3) units from the Pharmacology Category and at least one course (3 units) from the Toxicology category. The remaining 12 units can include additional courses from the Pharmacology and Toxicology categories, and courses from the PharmTox Elective category.
- A minimum GPA of 2.0 is required in the minor coursework.
- **At least 6 units must be unique to the minor, and not double-dipped with any other degree requirements.**
